Theme: The Glory of the Messiah

Glory Latin gloria, fame, renown is used to describe the manifestation of God's presence as perceived by humans according to the Abrahamic religions. The Hebrew word which is used for glory in the Old Testament has the simple meaning of "heaviness" or "weight". It was used in everyday speech to express the worth of a person in the material sense, and then to express the ideas of importance, greatness, honour, splendour, power and so on. God's glory reflects his essential nature. Moreover, God is the source of all good things. He actually shares his glory with us. When we receive his plentiful gifts with gratitude, when we use thyme to enhance his honour, when we acknowledge him as the source of all goodness, then we are glorifying him.

What is the glory that God gives us?

The word glory in the Bible always means something or someone who deserves great adoration, something or someone who deserves great thanksgiving, something or someone who deserves great honour and something or someone who is highly worthy to be praised! But we could ask what is there to be happy about. After all, there are so many things that depress us and make us sad. Yet we are asked to rejoice, to be a Christian we have to have joy in our lives. Isaiah 61, points out that we should rejoice in the Lord! Isaiah believes he has been chosen to bring good news to the poor, to heal the broken hearted, to bring liberty to captives, freedom to those in prison, to proclaim the joyful news that God will do all these things for us through the Messiah. Many people spend their lives in obscurity. They live in small communities and hidden places



Awareness Program on legal matters



But his first objective is to earn enough to make sure that his father does not need to hop on his bicycle any more to sell his wares in the village of Saltora, Bankura. The Glory of the Messiah

Glory brings to mind brightness and light. As we approach Christmas we can picture the sky full of angels, a very bright light, maybe so bright we cannot look but we can hear them praising God singing, "Glory to God in the highest and peace to his people on earth" (Luke 2:14) as they look down on this new little baby, a very special baby, the promised Messiah, lying in a manger stall. This little baby that would change the world then and is still doing so today.

Pictures and paintings often portray Christ with a halo of light around his head, showing his glory as a manifestation of light; Jesus is the light of the World. His glory, his magnificence and great beauty from within shining out into this world, shining out for us, looking for every knee to bow and every tongue to confess that Jesus is Lord of lords and King of kings.

It is not often with blinding light like Saul had on the road to Damascus that changed him into the faithful servant Paul who brought the good news to so many people even when in prison. We can follow his example and we can still feel his presence and his glory when we set time aside. We can find places where his presence comes and we know he is with us and we are in his presence, we feel him and his glory surrounding us.

Charles Wesley (1707 - 1788) writes in one of his hymns:

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SOCIAL ACTION

The COVID-19 pandemic has led to a dramatic loss of human life worldwide and presented an unprecedented challenge to public health, food systems and the world of work. The economic and social disruption caused by the pandemic was devastating exposing persistent inequalities by income, age, race, sex and geographic location. The CDP Project area covering most of the rural communities of Sarenga and urban slums of Durgapur also suffered the scarcity that ruled their livelihoods. Most of the people were out of employment and went through a huge economic breakdown. To overcome the desperate situations CDP under Diocese of Durgapur focused completely on diminishing the ongoing crisis and took the initiative to support the community with the immediate necessities such as food kits, medical equipments (digital thermometers, sanitizers, masks etc.), educational supplies and nutritional snacks (for study centre children) etc.

Despite the hurdles the project has successfully completed the previous phase and is on the present phase with inclusion of additional project areas and new interventions (Safeguarding, Gender Equality, Disability Inclusion, Adolescents, etc.). The past 2 years were quite difficult but we also got to adapt new ways to stay connected and carry on with the purpose of the project. Most of the work was accomplished through online meetings and workshops. In 2021, the CDP covered an external evaluation conducted by ASK as per the suggestion of UnitingWorld which came up with various learnings and recommendations to be incorporated in the next project plan. Recently Ms. Shreshtha Kumar, International Programs Manager, UnitingWorld visited the CDP project areas and she appreciated the service the Diocese has extended through this project with the marginalised communities. She has been connected with UnitingWorld since 2021 and due to the pandemic situation the communication remained virtual. It was her first visit in CDP, Durgapur project area and it was a wonderful experience for her to be able to connect with the community people as well as the staff and witness the transformation created through the untiring initiation. We together also contributed our views and ideas for preparing the next project design plan so that we can meet the needs of the community to its fullest. She also expressed greetings on behalf of the Uniting World, Australia during her meeting with the Bishop, Diocesan Office Bearers and other dignitaries as well as appreciated the progressive efforts of the project in building a better and stronger community to lead a life with dignity.
