

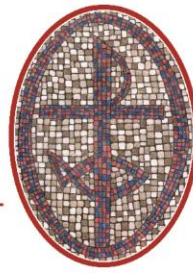
DSPR-MECC Update

November 2024

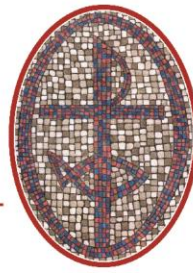
Thirteen months have passed since DSPR decided to continue and intensify its mission in Gaza Strip, despite the loss of lives, the very harsh living conditions, and the limited resources our teams are proceeding in the humanitarian response plan.

Primary health care services are beyond, **psychosocial support** projects, **basic medical laboratory services**, **offering medicine**, **food complementary and supplements**, **food and nonfood items** distribution, **unrestricted cash support** and active participation in the **Polio Vaccination Campaign**.



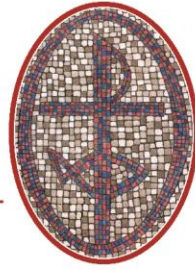


These services are offered in medical points in Gaza City and the Central districts of Gaza Strip, as well as in the mobile services DSPR is offering in the remote areas where people are deprived of services. Every day the teams revise their intervention plans, more than 100 team members run to their work locations, many of them are living in tents, almost all of them are forcedly displaced, but miraculously they are recharged with a renewable energy, faith and dedication to serve those who are facing the genocide and surviving with this unprecedented pain.





Two months ago we lost our colleague Wala' Al Masi with her daughter Mira, on 26th of October our colleague Mohamad AbuAlfoul, the Aluminum Workshop instructor in one of our vocational Training Centers has been killed, and yesterday we received another shocking news about our colleague Doha Musbeh, 27 years old, who has been killed with her both of her children, her mother, father and brother in an Israeli bombardment to her family home in Gaza city, where she moved after the bombardment of an apartment building where her dream home for her and her husband used to be.

Doha was a midwife working as a team member in the DSPR medical point in Gaza city after being a volunteer for several months, Doha and her husband get married in 2020. She insisted on continuing her university study to be a midwife, they got two children after hard transplantation process. Doha was so ambitious, she was planning to continue her study to in Master Program, she insisted to educate her children although there is no education in Gaza under this genocide, she recruited them in an unformal education with other children. Doha was very kind dedicated and hardworking young women with high dreams and big heart, may her soul rest in peace.
