Over 100 faith, human rights, and civil rights groups urgently call on Secretary Rubio to act now to free the Florida child imprisoned by Israel

Dear Secretary of State Marco Rubio,

We are a coalition of over 100 U.S. faith-based, human rights, and civil rights organizations, demanding that the U.S. government act now to ensure the safe release of Florida child Mohammed Ibrahim, a 16-year-old US citizen, unjustly imprisoned by the Israeli military since February.

Mohammed's health is dire and requires your immediate action to ensure Mohammed is free, safe, and with his parents—his life is on the line. According to his attorneys, Mohammed is suffering from scabies and has not received any medication; he has also lost over 30 pounds due to Israel denying him food and medical treatment. The Israeli military is holding Mohammed in Israel's notorious Ofer prison, a known place of abuse of Palestinian children. Prior to Ofer, Mohammed was held in Megiddo prison, also known for Israel's abuse of Palestinian children, specifically leading to "malnutrition, illness, and death".

Mohammed's imprisonment in Megiddo prison, located inside Israel, is also a flagrant violation of the 4th Geneva Convention, Article 49 of which strictly prohibits the deportation of protected persons from an Occupied Territory to the territory of the Occupying Power.

In February, over 30 heavily armed Israeli soldiers broke into Mohammed's family home in the West Bank at 3 AM, blindfolded and tied Mohammed's hands behind his back, and ripped him away from his mother and father. Mohammed traveled to his family's home in the West Bank for a family vacation to see loved ones. The Israeli military took Mohammed when he was only 15 years old, forcing him to spend his 16th birthday in an Israeli military prison, terrified and separated from his parents.

For 6 months, the Israeli military has unjustly imprisoned Mohammed, a child, without a trial, forcing his parents to live a non-stop nightmare. Israel has not allowed Mohammed's parents to contact him since he was taken. **Mohammed is an American child with a community in Florida who cares about him deeply.** It is the responsibility of the U.S. government to protect all American children, including Palestinian-Americans.

Mohammed is also the first cousin of <u>Sayfollah Musallet</u>, the 20-year-old Palestinian American man who was beaten to death by Israeli settlers last month. **Dozens of <u>Palestinian-American families own land in the West Bank Palestinian cities and villages that are increasingly being targeted by Israeli settlers and the Israeli military.** Yet, Palestinian-American families are not receiving any protection from the US government against rising Israeli settler and Israeli military violence against them.</u>

Numerous human rights groups have repeatedly <u>documented</u> Israel's systematic abuse of imprisoned Palestinian children, such as torture and violent physical abuse. In April 2025, <u>a</u> 17-year-old Palestinian boy who had been imprisoned in Megiddo collapsed and died due to the <u>abusive conditions</u> there. In July 2023, <u>Save the Children</u> issued a disturbing <u>report</u> stating that Israel's abuse of Palestinian children in prison has soared.

We are demanding that the U.S. Department of State work to secure the immediate release of Mohammed Ibrahim from Israeli prison and protect US citizens, particularly children. As a coalition of faith-based, human rights, and civil rights organizations, we stress the urgency of Mohammed's health and that a child's life is on the line.
